Rajesh Bindal, J.

Order passed by the learned Single Judge on 6.11.2012 has been impugned in the present appeal. An application seeking condonation delay of 1,749 days in filing the appeal has also been filed.

The relief claimed in the writ petition was for compassionate appointment on account of death of Paryag Chand, who died on 12.4.1994, while working as Patwari.

The writ petition was filed in the year 2010. After dismissal thereof on 6.11.2012, the present appeal has been filed on 21.9.2017, after a delay of 1,749 days, for which there is no explanation. The writ petition seeking compassionate appointment on account of death of Paryag Chand filed more than 16 years after his death was dismissed by the learned Single Judge being highly belated.

There is no ground made out for condoning huge delay of 1,743 days in filing the appeal. The application seeking condonation of delay is dismissed. Consequently, the appeal is also dismissed.
