Order passed by the learned Single Judge dismissing the writ petition, has been impugned in the present intra court appeal.

2. The issue raised by the appellant was that he is eligible for the post of driver as he is having a valid driving license for the last more than 5 years. The requirement is not that the driving license should be for Light and Heavy Motor Vehicles for the last 5 years. Only the experience has been required as driver for 5 years which the appellant possesses.

3. The issue has been considered by the learned Single Judge. Once, the driving license is required for Light and Heavy Motor Vehicles, the period of experience is to be read in conjunction therewith.

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Otherwise, the same will defeat the very purpose of prescribing the period of experience of driving a vehicle.

4. Therefore, we do not find any error in the order passed by the learned Single Judge.
