The order dated 25.8.2017 has been challenged by filing the present intra-court appeal.

In the writ petition, challenge was to the order dated 13.11.1996, whereby the claim of the appellant for appointment to the post of Sub-Staff was rejected, as he was not found medically fit. Keeping in view the totality of the circumstances and age of the appellant, the writ petition was disposed of directing payment of compensation of ₹ 1,00,000/- to the appellant.

Learned counsel for the caveators-respondents submitted that the appellant had accepted the amount of compensation, as determined by the learned Single Judge.

The aforesaid fact is not disputed by learned counsel for the appellant.

As the appellant has accepted the amount of compensation determined by the learned Single Judge, he is estopped from challenging the order seeking further relief.

Accordingly, the appeal is dismissed. Consequently, the application for condonation of delay in filing thereof is also dismissed.
