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**RAJESH BINDAL, J.**

The order passed by the learned Single Judge dated 3.5.2017 allowing the writ petition by quashing the order of dismissal of the respondent, has been impugned in the present intra Court appeal. Along with the appeal an application seeking condonation of delay of 104 days in filing the appeal is also filed.

The facts stated in the application seeking condonation of delay do not justify delayed filing of the appeal. Even otherwise, in the case in hand, the writ petitioner was dismissed on account of his conviction in criminal case. However, subsequently his conviction was set aside, hence the writ petition filed by him was allowed. Dismissal was solely on the basis of conviction in the criminal case.

For the reasons stated above, we do not find that any

ground is made out either for condoning delay in filing the appeal and even on merits as well.

Accordingly, the appeal is dismissed. Consequently, the accompanying applications are also dismissed
