RAJESH BINDAL, J.

The order passed by the learned Single Judge dismissing the writ petition has been impugned by filing the present intra Court appeal.

The challenge in the writ petition was to the orders passed by the authorities pertaining to partition of the land. The process was initiated by other co-sharers. The mode of partition was approved. At every stage, before the revenue authorities upto the Financial Commissioner the appellant failed. Even the writ petition was also dismissed. The appellant had not been able to make out a case for interference even before the learned Single Judge. The appellant had not been able to point out as to how much less land was given to him as compared to his entitlement. Sanad Takseem had already been issued which was never challenged.

Single Judge while concurring with the views expressed in the orders impugned. We do not find any error therein. The appeal is accordingly dismissed. Consequently, the applications for condonation of delay in filing/refiling the appeal are also dismissed.
