1. In the instant appeal, appellant has questioned the interest part awarded by the appellate Court dated 14.05.2015 to the extent of denying 18 per cent .
2. Heard learned counsel for the parties.
3. Undisputedly, respondents have extended the benefit of appellate Court's order to the extent of 12% interest on the belated settlement of retiral benefits. Appellant has not made out a case for extending benefit of interest @ 18% per annum. What is required to be taken into consideration for the purpose of payment of interest on belated settlement of retiral benefits is bank interest at the relevant period. Therefore, nothing remains in the present appeal.
4. Accordingly, instant appeal stands disposed of.
