The order passed by the learned Single Judge dismissing the writ petition has been impugned by filing the present intra-court appeal.

The claim made in the writ petition was regarding appointment of the appellant as Constable as a special case as the family was attacked by the terrorists way back on 22.8.1990. Bravery award was also given to the mother of the appellant in the year 1991. The appellant kept quiet for more than a decade. Once his case was recommended by Director General of Police, Punjab to the Government, however, the same was rejected vide communication dated 17.6.2005. Then mother of the appellant again made a request. The submission is that the same is still pending and a direction be issued to the respondents to consider the same.

It is not in dispute that there is no policy as such on the basis of which the appellant is claiming appointment as Constable, that too more than two decades after the alleged incident of terrorists' attack took place. In

the absence of any right, no direction can be given by the court for disposal of the claim of the appellant, even if the delay is ignored. There is no merit in the present appeal. Accordingly, the same is dismissed.
