The order passed by the learned Single Judge dismissing the writ petition has been impugned by filing the present intra-court appeal.

The issue raised was regarding appointment of Lambardar. It has been found that the appellant-petitioner had produced certificates of 10th and 12th stating that he had passed those examinations from Board of Secondary Education, Madhya Bharat, Gwalior (for short, 'the Board'), which were found to be fake and forged. Even the Board was not recognised.

Considering the aforesaid facts and the qualifications and experience of respondent No. 3, who was appointed as Lambardar, we do

not find any error in the order passed by the learned Single Judge.

Accordingly, the appeal is dismissed. Consequently, the application for condonation of delay in filing the appeal is also dismissed.
