Challenge in the present intra-court appeal is to the order dated 06.11.2017 passed by the learned Single Judge whereby writ petition filed by the appellants claiming appointment on compassionate basis being elder brother and nephew of deceased Amarjit Singh who was serving as Constable with Punjab Police was dismissed. It is claimed that he was killed by the terrorists on 07.02.1992. Immediately thereafter, Daljit Singh younger brother of deceased Amarjit Singh was given appointment as Constable on compassionate basis in October 1992.

The writ petition was filed by the appellants, who are elder brother and nephew of the deceased Amarjit Singh, more than 25 years after the incident took place. To claim compassionate appointment at this stage, no policy as such has been referred in terms of which more than one member

of the family could be offered appointment and that too after 25 years of the death of the employee.

There is no error in the order passed by the learned Single Judge.

The present appeal is accordingly dismissed.
