Aggrieved against the order passed by the learned Single Judge dismissing the writ petition filed by the petitioner, present intra-Court appeal has been filed.

The appellant was appointed as Art and Craft Mistress in Bal Bhawan, Jind on 24.03.1994. It is claimed that her services were regularized on 24.09.2003. However, she was terminated on 15.01.2010. Thereafter, CWP No.7002 of 2010 was filed challenging the order of termination which was dismissed as withdrawn on 21.04.2010 with liberty to make representation. The representation preferred by the appellant was rejected vide communication dated 17.08.2010. The same was challenged by filing CWP No.1014 of 2011 which was dismissed as withdrawn on 22.05.2012.

As has been noticed in the impugned order, the appellant filed a mercy petition before the Governor of Haryana being President of State

Council for Child Welfare and the appellant was offered fresh appointment against the post of Art and Craft Teacher on 08.02.2017 which was reiterated on 30.05.2017 but the appellant failed to join duties within the time permissible. Hence, even that offer of appointment was also cancelled.

Considering the fact that the order of termination of the appellant obtained finality way back on 22.05.2012 when the writ petition filed by her challenging the order rejecting her representation was dismissed as withdrawn, we cannot at this stage entertain the issue to be considered on merits.

For the reasons mentioned above, we do not find any error in the order passed by the learned Single Judge. Hence, the present appeal is dismissed. Consequently, the application seeking condonation of 10 days' delay in filing the appeal is also dismissed.
