Rajesh Bindal, J.

Order passed by the learned Single Judge dated 19.1.2017 dismissing the writ petition has been challenged in the present intra-court appeal.

In the writ petition, the challenge was made to the order dated 22.7.2005, whereby the husband of the appellant was dismissed from service on being absent from duty and further his right to claim pensionary benefits, was also declined.

All the arguments raised by the writ petitioner were considered in detail by the learned Single Judge. Another fact, which dis-entitle her any relief from the Court is that the petition filed in this Court impugning the order dated 22.7.2005 was highly belated as it was filed more than nine years thereafter.

Hence, we do not find any ground to interfere with the order
impugned in the present appeal. The appeal is accordingly dismissed.
Consequently, the applications for condonation of delay are also dismissed.
