This intra-court appeal filed under clause X of the Letters Patent is directed against the judgment and order of the learned Single Judge dated 30.04.2018 dismissing the writ petition filed by the appellants herein.

The facts relevant for the purpose of the case are: that the appellants and the private respondents were co-sharers of the land in question, which was a subject matter of acquisition by the Government for the purpose of maintenance, management and operation of National Highway No.71. As there was a dispute with respect to absolute ownership, the petitioners/ appellants made a representation under Section 3H(4) of the National Highway Act, 1956. The award was drawn in favour of all the co-sharers and they were held entitled to compensation in proportion to their respective shares. It is well settled that every co-sharer is entitled to compensation in accordance with his share. On the said proposition of law,

learned Single Judge dismissed the writ petition. We do not find illegality in the same to interfere with the matter. The appeal being devoid of merit is accordingly dismissed.
