Order passed by the learned Single Judge dated 18.10.2016 dismissing the writ petition has been impugned by filing the present intra-court appeal.

Prayer made in the writ petition was for release of 'capital investment incentive stock subsidy'. The learned Single Judge dismissed the writ petition finding the same to be highly belated. Another fact which is important is that the Unit of the petitioner/appellant was closed in the year 2008. The incentives are given by the State to promote industrialization and not to the industries which are set up and closed merely 3-4 years thereafter. The writ petition having been filed more than five years after the closer of the Unit has rightly been dismissed by the learned Single Judge.

There is no error in the order passed by the learned Single Judge.

The present appeal is, accordingly, dismissed.
