RAJESH BINDAL, J.

Order passed by the learned Single Judge disposing of the writ petition has been impugned by filing the present intra-court appeal. Challenge in the writ petition was to the order of punishment of stoppage of three increments with cumulative effect inflicted on the appellant after the departmental enquiry. There is no grievance regarding the enquiry being properly conducted.

In exercise of the powers of the judicial review, the learned Single Judge, keeping in view the totality of the circumstances, reduced the punishment to stoppage of two increments with cumulative effect as against stoppage of three increments with cumulative effect inflicted on the appellant by the Departmental authority.

We do not find any error in the order passed by the learned Single Judge.

For the reasons stated above, the present appeal is dismissed. Consequently, the application for condonation of delay of 24 days in filing the appeal is also dismissed.
