The only grievance of the appellant is that the order dated 12.5.2015 was set aside by the learned Single Judge without issuing notice to the private respondents / affected parties.

The aforesaid fact is not disputed by learned counsel for the respondents.

After hearing learned counsel for the parties, in our view, the order passed by the learned Single Judge allowing the writ petition without issuing notice to the respondents and setting aside the order passed in their favour deserves to be set aside as opportunity of hearing should have been granted to the appellant herein.

Ordered accordingly.

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Let the matter be placed before the learned Single Judge for decision on merits as per roster. All the contesting parties are represented by their respective counsels. They are directed to appear before the learned Single Judge on 19.1.2018.

The appeal stands disposed of accordingly.
