Order passed by the learned Single Judge dated 26.10.2016 allowing the writ petition has been impugned by filing the present intra-court appeal.

The issue raised in the writ petition was regarding the benefit of service rendered by the respondent during second National Emergency.

Learned counsel for the appellants fairly stated that identical issue was involved in LPA No.159 of 2017 titled as Director General of Police (IRB), Punjab and others v. Swarup Singh @ Saroop Singh wherein upholding the similar order passed by the learned Single Judge, the said appeal has been dismissed vide order dated 02.05.2017.

For the detailed reasons recorded in the Swarup Singh @ Saroop Singh’s case (supra), there is no merit in the present appeal. Accordingly, the same is dismissed. Consequently, the application seeking condonation of delay in filing the appeal is also dismissed.
