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RAJESH BINDAL, J.

Order dated 21.11.2016 passed by the learned Single Judge dismissing the writ petition pertaining to a dispute regarding partition of land has been impugned by filing the present intra-court appeal. The issue sought to be raised by learned counsel for the appellant is that he was not heard before the mode of partition proceedings were finalized. However, the documents on record especially the site plan at page no.71 of the paper-book shows that the appellant has not been able to establish any prejudice with the mode of partition as all the co-sharers have been given land at three different places according to their shares. Their share in the joint khewat has also been protected. Learned Single Judge has considered the entire

matter in great depth.

We do not find any error in the order passed by the learned Single Judge. Accordingly, the appeal is dismissed. Consequently, the application for condonation of delay in filing the appeal is also dismissed.
