Challenge in the present Letters Patent appeal is to the order dated March 18, 2017 passed by the learned Single Judge.

Issue arises out of an application filed by the respondent Nos.1 and 2 seeking relief under the Maintenance and Welfare of Parents and Senior Citizens Act, 2007.

The facts of the case are not required to be mentioned in details as during the pendency of the present appeal as undertaken by the appellants they had vacated the house in question. The only dispute remains regarding the payment of the maintenance.

It has been agreed between the parties that as full and final

settlement for the amount of maintenance payable, the appellants will pay a sum of ₹45,000/- to the respondent Nos.1 and 2 upto May 31, 2018 in four installments.

In view of the above settlement, the present Letters Patent Appeal is disposed of, accordingly.
