Order passed by the learned Single Judge dismissing the writ petition has been impugned by filing the present intra-court appeal.

Order challenged before the learned Single Judge was passed by the authorities whereby the appellant was discharged during the period of probation. The appellant was appointed as Constable and joined his service on 04.04.2012. Till the time he was discharged, during probation he absented from duty for 174 days on 33 different occasions.

Considering the fact that the appellant, who was part of a disciplined force, absented for 174 days even during the period of his probation, he has rightly been discharged from his service.

There is no error in the order passed by the learned Single Judge.

The present appeal is accordingly dismissed. Consequently, the application seeking condonation of delay in filing the appeal is also dismissed.
