Rajesh Bindal, J.

Order passed by the learned Single Judge has been impugned by filing the present intra-court appeal. Along with the appeal, applications seeking 96 days' delay in filing and 21 days' delay in refiling thereof, have also been filed.

The husband of the appellant died during the course of employment in the year 1990. Writ petition was filed in the year 2011 seeking compassionate appointment or ex-gratia payment. Taking compassionate view of the matter, the learned Single Bench directed for payment of ₹2,50,000/- as ex-gratia to the appellant. As the issue was raised by the appellant more than two decades after the death of her husband, we do not find any reason to interfere with the impugned order passed by the learned Single Judge as the amount has been awarded to the appellant considering the policies which were framed later on.

Accordingly, the appeal is dismissed. Consequently, the applications seeking condonation of delay in filing and refiling the appeal are also dismissed.
