Rajesh Bindal, J.

Order passed by the learned Single Judge dismissing the writ petition has been impugned by filing the present intra-court appeal.

Late husband of the appellant was working as Constable with the Punjab Police. He expired on 21.11.2009. The writ petition was filed in May, 2013, claiming that her husband should have been granted ACP Scale with effect from 1.1.1996.

The writ petition having been filed more than 3 years 6 months, even after the death of the husband of the appellant, has rightly been dismissed on account of delay and laches. The appeal is dismissed. As there is no merit in the appeal, the application for condonation of delay of 397 days in filing the appeal is also dismissed.
