The order passed by the learned Single Judge dismissing the writ petition has been challenged by filing the present intra-court appeal. Along with the appeal, an application seeking condonation of delay of 221 days in filing thereof has also been filed.

The prayer made in the writ petition was for grant of appointment on compassionate ground. Father of the appellant died on 27.9.2009. The application was submitted by the appellant for the first time on 12.10.2015, which was highly belated. Since the object of compassionate appointment being only to give immediate succor to the family of the deceased employee, the writ petition was dismissed.

Prima facie, we do not find any merit in the present appeal. However, as none has appeared for the appellant, the appeal as well as application for condonation of delay in filing thereof are dismissed for non-prosecution.
