Order passed by the learned Single Judge dismissing the writ petition has been impugned by filing the present intra-court appeal. Along with the appeal, applications seeking condonation of 15 days' delay in filing and 211 days' delay in refiling thereof, have also been filed.

The appellant, who joined service as S.S. Mistress on 19.11.1973, regularized w.e.f. 17.10.1982, retired from service on 30.04.2008. She filed writ petition in the year 2014 praying for direction to count service rendered by her on adhoc/leave arrangement basis towards pensionary benefits. Out of the total service rendered as such on ad hoc/leave arrangement basis, intermittently for short-short periods for about four years prior to the regular appointment, part of that has already been counted for calculations of pensionary benefits. The only dispute remains regarding period of seven months. In the writ petition filed more than six years after retirement for this small benefit, the learned Single Judge has rightly declined to interfere.

There is no error in the order passed by the learned Single Judge, accordingly, the present appeal is dismissed. Consequently, the applications seeking condonation of delay in filing and refiling the appeal are also dismissed.
