Order passed by learned Single Judge dated 5.12.2017 dismissing the writ petition opining that the issues sought to be raised by the appellant cannot be gone into in writ jurisdiction, has been impugned by the appellant by filing the present appeal.

It is claimed that the resolution as passed has been sent by the Sarpanch to the District Development and Panchayat Officer for opening a liquor shop in the village. It is alleged that signatures of eight of the Panches on the resolution have been forged.

The learned Single Judge opined that to prove the allegation of forgery, the evidence would be required. Hence, the issue cannot be gone into in the writ jurisdiction.

The appellant may avail of appropriate remedy for redressal of her grievances. There is no error in the order passed by the learned Single

Judge. The appeal is accordingly dismissed. Consequently, the application for condonation of delay is also dismissed.
