The order passed by the learned Single Judge dismissing the writ petition has been impugned by filing the present intra-court appeal.

The challenge in the writ petition was to the order dated 29.4.2016, whereby claim of the appellants of higher grade pay was rejected. It has been noticed by the learned Single Judge in the impugned order that the State had constituted the Pay Commission, which made its recommendations. The employees were informed about the same and were invited to send their objections to the Anomaly Committee, but no objections were filed by the appellants. Whatever objections were received, the same were duly considered. Once the appellants were not aggrieved against the recommendations made the Pay Commission at that time, the Court declined to interfere.

On 3.4.2017, time was taken by learned counsel for the appellants to find out as to whether Pay Anomaly Committee, as constituted on 21.12.2011, was still functional, however, till date, despite repeated adjournments, information has not been furnished.

For the reasons mentioned above, we do not find any error in the order passed by the learned Single Judge. The appeal is, accordingly, dismissed. Consequently, the application for condonation of delay in filing thereof is also dismissed.
