Challenge in the present intra-court appeal is to the order dated 12.12.2016 passed by the learned Single Judge whereby the writ petition filed by the appellant, challenging the policy decision dated 26.11.2015 had been dismissed.

Reason recorded was that the appellant had already filed a civil suit for the same relief which was pending at Delhi. The policy is regarding change/correction of dates of birth in the passport.

We do not find that the reason assigned by the learned Single Judge for dismissing the writ petition is, in any way, erroneous as a party cannot be permitted to avail parallel remedies for the same relief.

Accordingly, the appeal has no merit and the same is dismissed. Consequently, the application seeking condonation of 135 days' delay in filing the appeal is also dismissed.
