This order will dispose of LPA Nos.934 and 995 of 2017 as the same have arisen out of common judgment dated 01.05.2017 passed by learned Single Judge.

After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the appellant(s) submits that during the course of hearing of the writ petition(s) by the interim orders certain exercise had been conducted and directions formulated almost concluding the controversy but in the final order those orders do not find any mention.

Learned State counsel has filed reply on behalf of respondent

No.1 in LPA No.934 of 2017 in Court today, which is taken on record. She further submits that interim orders lose its significance once the final order was passed.

Looking at the contentions raised and noticing that during the course of hearing, certain interim orders were indeed passed which according to learned counsel for the appellant(s) do not find any mention in the final disposal of the matter, we are of the opinion that the grievance of the kind raised ought to have been raised before the learned Single Judge as it is he who can appreciate the relevance of the interim orders passed during the course of hearing. We, therefore, dispose of the appeal(s) with liberty to the appellant(s) to raise such a grievance before the learned Single Judge.

The present appeals are disposed of accordingly,.
