Order passed by the learned Single Judge dated 01.03.2017 dismissing the writ petition has been impugned by filing the present intra-court appeal.

The dispute arises out of the partition proceedings. The appellant sought to claim that khewat No.148 be also included in the partition proceedings. However, there is a definite finding given by the authorities below and the learned Single Judge of this Court that Khewat No.148 is not part of the joint ownership of the parties. Hence, there is no question of its inclusion for the purpose of partition proceedings.

There is no error in the order passed by the learned Single Judge.

Accordingly, the present appeal is dismissed. Consequently, the application seeking condonation of delay in filing the appeal is also dismissed.
