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KRISHNA MURARI, C.J. (ORAL)

On account of certain conditions imposed by Punjab State Power Corporation Limited and non-compliance thereof on account of a dispute between the appellant and his brother, the tube-well connection released to the appellant was withdrawn. The order was challenged before the learned Single Judge by the appellant, but the writ petition was dismissed against which the present appeal has been preferred. During the pendency of the appeal, the appellant and his brother have entered into compromise dated 06.11.2018 which is taken on record.

2. Learned counsel for the appellant states that since the brother of the appellant, who is a co-owner of the land on which the tube-well was installed, is ready to give no objection for want of which the connection was withdrawn, there

should be no impediment with Punjab State Power Corporation Limited in granting the same.

3. Be that as it may, since the appellant intends to withdraw the present appeal, we permit him to do so with an observation that Punjab State Power Corporation Limited may now proceed in accordance with law and the prescribed procedure for grant of electricity connection for establishing the tube-well.

4. With the aforesaid observation and direction, the appeal stands disposed of.
