Mr. Sharad Aggarwal, learned Assistant Advocate General, Haryana, appearing for the respondents on the basis of instructions, states that application of the appellant made for registration has been rejected on two grounds, namely, defect in the affidavit and he was a defaulter.

2. Once this order has been passed on the application made by the appellant, the same is completely new cause of action and thus nothing survives in this appeal. The same accordingly stands dismissed as having been rendered infructuous. However, it shall be open to the appellant to challenge the order of rejection of his application in case it is so advised before an appropriate forum, in accordance with law.
