The order dated 11.12.2017, passed by the learned Single Judge, whereby the writ petition filed by the appellant seeking a direction for action against respondents No. 4 and 5, namely, Amardev (Sarpanch) and Maya Devi (Ex-Sarpanch) for mis-appropriation of MANREGA funds was dismissed, has been impugned in the present intra-court appeal.

The reason mentioned in the impugned order is that to show his *bona fide*, the appellant was directed to deposit ₹ 1,00,000/- with the Registry so that the private respondents could be compensated in case the allegations made in the writ petition were ultimately found to be false.

Needful was not done. The writ petition was dismissed. There is no error in the order passed by the learned Single Judge.

Accordingly, the appeal is dismissed.
