The order dated 20.12.2017, passed by the learned Single Judge upholding order dated 8.11.2017, passed by District Magistrate, Jalandhar under the Maintenance and Welfare of Parents and Senior Citizen Act, 2007 (for short, 'the Act'), has been impugned in the present intra-court appeal. The appeal is accompanied by application seeking condonation of delay of 11 days in filing thereof.

Respondent No. 4 in the present case is about 90 years of age. The relations between the appellant and respondent No. 4 are not cordial as there are other litigations pending or decided. The plea sought to be raised by the appellant is that the house in question is not in the name of respondent No. 4, however, the fact is not disputed that the house in question was given to the wife (deceased) of respondent No. 4 by her

brother and they had been residing therein. The wife has since expired. As the appellant was not having cordial relations with respondent No. 4 and was not maintaining him, application under the Act was filed.

In the aforesaid factual matrix, we do not find any error in the order passed by the learned Single Judge. Accordingly, the appeal is dismissed. Consequently, the application for condonation of delay is also dismissed.
