Rajesh Bindal, J.

Order passed by learned Single Judge dismissing the writ petition whereby challenge was made to the revised route plan for installation of 66 KV power transmission line from village Naudharani Grid to village Hathan.

The reasons assigned by the authorities for change in route have been considered by the learned Single Judge. It has further been noticed that more than 60% work as per the revised route plan has already been completed. In any case, Section 10(c) of the Indian Telegraph Act, 1885, which is applicable for the purpose of acquisition of right to use for installation of transmission lines, does not provide for opportunity of hearing. While erecting lines, the authority does not acquire any right other than that of user of the property, which is subject to payment of compensation.

Considering the aforesaid facts, we do not find any error in the order passed by the learned Single Judge. Accordingly, the appeal is dismissed.
