The issue raised by the appellants is pertaining to answer key to five questions at Sr. Nos. 50, 53, 69, 71 and 74. In support, learned counsel for the appellants has referred to some books, in terms of which the answer key is not correct.

Mr. B. R. Mahajan, learned Advocate General submitted that the question paper was prepared by the expert in the subject. The objections raised to the answer key were also examined by him. Though the Rules do not provide for its examination by any other Expert Committee, but still to rule out any possibility of error, five questions, as pointed out by learned counsel for the appellants, can be got examined from an independent expert.

Let these five questions with answer key be sent to the Head of Sanskrit Department in Kurukshetra University, Kurukshetra, who along with two other senior teachers in the department will opine as to which of

the answer in four options or none of them given in each of the question is correct. The question paper along with the answer key be sent to the Head of Sanskrit Department in Kurukshetra University within one week from today. Report regarding correctness of the answer key, along with supporting material, will be sent by the Head of Sanskrit Department in Kurukshetra University to the Chairman of the Haryana Staff Selection Commission (for short, 'the Commission') within one week after receipt thereof from the Commission.

It has been agreed upon by the parties that whatever report is submitted by the Head of Sanskrit Department in Kurukshetra University, the same shall be accepted by the Commission and further action shall be taken for revising the result, if required.

The answer key with correct answers suggested by the Head of Sanskrit Department in Kurukshetra University shall be uploaded on the website of the Commission after receipt of the report.

With the modification of the order passed by the learned Single Judge in the aforesaid terms, the appeal stands disposed of.
