RAJESH BINDAL, J:

Order dated 06.06.2014, passed by the Controlling Authority under the Payment of Wages Act, 1936 (for short the 'Act') and Labour-cum-Conciliation Officer, Circle-I, Ludhiana (for short the 'Controlling Authority') was challenged by filing the writ petition. The same was dismissed by the learned Single Judge as wages claimed by the appellant were for the period from 06.05.1969 to 31.05.1993. The claim was also dismissed by the Controlling Authority as the appellant had not been able to make out his case. The appellant had retired from service on 31.03.2006, a decade before filing writ petition.

Considering the aforesaid facts, where wages for the period from 06.05.1969 to 31.05.1993 were sought to be claimed by the appellant by filing an application before the Controlling Authority much after his retirement, we do not find any error in the order passed by the learned Single Judge.

The appeal is, accordingly, dismissed.
