After the matter was heard for some time, learned counsel for the appellant was confronted with an observation with respect to the merits of this appeal inasmuch as the predecessor-in-interest of the appellant got his claim registered with Registrar, Refugee Claims, Government of East Punjab in respect of property left by him in Multan District as far back as in 1948. There is nothing on record to indicate that the father of the appellant ever made any efforts in this regard or the claim was even processed. It is only after his death, the appellant has come forward. Learned counsel for the appellant finding it difficult to assail the same sought leave of the Court to permit withdrawal of the appeal.

Prayer made is allowed.
Appeal is dismissed as withdrawn.
