Order passed by the learned Single Judge dated 23.01.2018 whereby in the writ petition filed by respondent No.1 orders dated 06.11.2001 and 20.08.2002 passed by respondent No.2, were set aside being without jurisdiction, has been challenged in the present intra-court appeal. Besides this, it was found that High Court will have no jurisdiction to decide the lis pertaining to the service matter of the employees working in Post and Telecom Department. No relief was granted to the appellant.

Learned counsel for the appellant submitted that as the jurisdiction to claim relief lies with the Central Administrative Tribunal, she may be permitted to withdraw the present appeal with liberty to file application before the Tribunal along with an application seeking condonation of delay. The same may be considered sympathetically as the

appellant under wrong advice had initially approached the Chief Commissioner for Persons with Disabilities, who had initially passed the order in favour of the appellant which was set aside by the learned Single Judge.

Ordered accordingly.
