RAJESH BINDAL, J.

The order passed by the learned Single Judge dismissing the writ petition has been challenged by filing the present intra-court appeal.

The appellants approached this Court with a prayer that the selection process for the post of Driver, which was initiated on 26.07.2011, should be completed. Finding that the Government had taken a policy decision to abandon the selection process there being no requirement and shortage of funds, the writ petition was dismissed.

We do not find any error in the order passed by the learned Single Judge as this is a matter of policy decision by Government as to whether they want to fill up the vacant post or not. In the case in hand, the selection process itself could not be concluded in pursuance to the decision taken to abandon the same. Even the selection also does not confer any right

of appointment as such.

There is no error in the order passed by the learned Single Judge.

Accordingly, the appeal is dismissed.
