The order passed by the learned Single Judge dismissing the writ petition has been impugned by filing the present intra-court appeal.

The appellant filed the writ petition seeking a direction to the respondents to offer appointment as Fireman, as he had been selected and was eligible for the post. One of the conditions of eligibility was experience. The experience certificate produced by the appellant from Director General of Home Guards and Civil Defence, New Delhi was found to be fake, on verification. Thereafter, the appellant produced another certificate from National Institute of Industrial Security dated nil.

As the initial conduct of the appellant was that he produced a fake certificate to seek public employment, *prima facie*, there is no error in the order passed by the learned Single Judge in dismissing the writ petition.

However, as none has appeared for the appellant, the appeal as well as

application for condonation of delay in filing thereof are dismissed for non-prosecution.
