The order passed by the learned Single Judge dismissing the writ petition has been challenged in the present intra-court appeal.

The appellant, who is working as Chief Engineer, impugned the order passed by the authorities, whereby charge of the Electrical Wing was given to a senior most Superintending Engineer (Electrical) to report directly to Engineer-in-Chief, Haryana. The grievance of the appellant is that half of his work has been taken from him which amounts to causing stigma on his working. Nothing as such is evident from the order impugned in the writ petition. The appellant remains as Chief Engineer. He has not been reverted. For rationalising the work in the department, the Government must have decided to give charge of the Electrical Wing to the senior most Superintending Engineer (Electrical).

There is no error in the order passed by the learned Single Judge.

Accordingly, the appeal is dismissed.
