The order passed by the learned Single Judge dismissing the writ petition has been challenged by filing the present intra-court appeal.

The prayer of the appellant-petitioner was for quashing the communication dated 16.6.2017 from Assistant Executive Engineer, Incharge Sub-Division, Punjab State Power Corporation Limited rejecting the request of the appellant for releasing of temporary power connection. The appellant had an earlier round of litigation. CWP No. 4620 of 2017 earlier filed by the appellant was disposed of on 25.5.2017 by directing the authorities to dispose of the request of the appellant by passing a speaking order. In pursuance thereto, the communication impugned in the writ petition was passed. It has been specifically recorded therein that though temporary connection has been sought for Gurudwara, however, what exists at the spot is only a temporary shed and as per the revenue record, the appellant is not even the owner of the place in question.

In view of the aforesaid facts, we do not find any error in the order passed by the learned Single Judge. Accordingly, the appeal is dismissed. Consequently, the application for condonation of delay in filing the appeal is also dismissed.
