Order passed by the learned Single Judge dismissing the writ petition has been impugned by filing the present intra Court appeal.

The challenge in the writ petition was to the advertisement dated 28.6.2016 issued by the Assistant Collector 2nd Grade, Charkhi Dadri inviting applications for filling up the post of Lambardar (General category) of Village Mandoli, Tehsil and District Charkhi Dadri and report dated 3.7.2017 sent by Assistant Collector 2nd Grade, Charkhi Dadri.

The claim of the appellant was that he had already been appointed as Lambardar on the basis of inheritance way back on 15.1.1979 after his father, who was Lambardar, died on 4.11.1978. Mutation had been

entered.

It was admitted that the appellant was in Government service and retired on 31.1.2003. Meaning thereby that for about 24 years he had been in Government service and was not performing responsibilities of Lambardar. Presently, he is about 72 years of age.

All the issues raised by the appellant have been considered in detail by the learned Single Judge.

In the light of the aforesaid facts, we do not find any error in the order passed by the learned Single Judge. There is no merit in the present appeal. The same is accordingly dismissed. Consequently, the application for condonation of delay in re-filing the appeal is also dismissed.
