Order passed by the learned Single Judge dismissing the writ petition on the ground of delay has been impugned in the present intra-Court appeal.

The appellants approached this Court in the year 2018 raising the grievance with regard to advertisement for selection to the post of Constables issued on 05.02.2011. The appointments were made thereafter. Certain candidates, who were appointed, also have been impleaded as private respondents. It is claimed that neither they were eligible nor they passed the written test or medical examination. Either they were absent or were found to be unfit but still given appointment. Even rejected candidates were also offered appointment. This was done in the year 2012. The writ petitioners challenged their appointment in the year 2018 and further seeking direction for the appointment of the appellants after six

years. The writ petition was rightly dismissed by the learned Single Judge on account of delay and laches as the issues cannot be reopened after nearly six years of appointments.

For the reasons stated above, there is no merit in the present appeal.

The appeal is accordingly dismissed.
