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RAJESH BINDAL, J.

Order passed by the learned Single Judge allowing the appellant's writ petition has been impugned by the State by filing the present intra-court appeal. Applications seeking condonation of delay of 67 days in re-filing and 215 days in filing the appeal have also been filed.

In the case in hand, the learned Single Judge directed grant of ex-gratia payment to the son of the deceased employee, who had died in harness on 07.12.1998, in terms of the Haryana Compassionate Assistance to the Dependents of Deceased Government Employees Rules, 2006 (for short – '2006 Rules'). It is not disputed that the case of the respondent was pending when the 2006 Rules came into force and in terms clause 6 thereof, all pending compassionate cases were to be dealt with under the 2006 Rules.

Considering the aforesaid facts, we do not find any error in the order passed by the learned Single Judge and the present appeal is, accordingly, dismissed. Consequently, the applications for condonation of delay in re-filing and filing of the appeal are also dismissed.
