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RAJESH BINDAL, J.

Order passed by the learned Single Judge, dismissing the appellant's writ petition, has been impugned by filing the present intra-court appeal. The applications seeking condonation of delay of 18 days in filing and 100 days in re-filing the appeal have also been filed.

The issue pertains to the appointment of Lambardar. The appellant is a practicing Advocate in the Civil Court at Kanina. The Lambardar pertains to village Rasulpur, Tehsil Kanina, District Mahendergarh, which is claimed to be at a distance of 3 km from Kanina. The order passed by the Collector appointing respondent No.5-Om Bir as Lambardar was upheld by all the Revenue Authorities as well as the learned Single Judge.

In view of the above, there is no error in the order passed passed by the learned Single Judge and the present appeal is, accordingly, dismissed. Consequently, the applications for condonation of delay in filing and re-filing of the appeal are also dismissed.
