RAJESH BINDAL, J:

Order dated 06.04.2016, passed by the learned Single Judge, dismissing the appellant's writ petition being highly belated, has been impugned by filing the present intra-court appeal. Alongwith appeal, an application seeking condonation of delay of 661 days in filing the appeal has also been filed.

The writ petition was filed seeking benefits of the Assured Career Progression Scheme on completion of 24 years of service w.e.f 09.08.1999. The appellant was discharged from service on 30.11.2002. The writ petition filed more than thirteen years thereafter was rightly dismissed by the learned Single Judge on account of delay and laches.

There is no error in the order passed by the learned Single Judge.

The appeal is, accordingly, dismissed. Consequently, application for condonation of delay in filing the appeal is also dismissed.
