The order passed by the learned Single Judge allowing the writ petition with a direction to the appellants to pay interest on delayed payment of retiral dues has been impugned by filing the present intra court appeal.

The respondent-employee was charge-sheeted. Disciplinary proceedings were pending on account of which part of retiral dues were withheld. However, even after culmination of disciplinary proceedings in July, 2010, balance retiral dues were not paid. The learned Single Judge granting buffer time, which could be utilised by the appellants for payment of the balance retiral dues, directed for payment of interest from 3.10.2010.

There is no error in the order impugned. Accordingly, the appeal is

dismissed. Consequently, the application for condonation of delay in filing the appeal is also dismissed.
