Order dated 28.11.2017, passed by the learned Single Judge, allowing the writ petition filed by respondent No. 3 has been impugned in the present appeal.

Application was filed by the appellant under the Maintenance and Welfare of parents and Senior Citizens Act, 2007. The property was transferred by the appellant in favour of respondent No. 3, who claimed that she is the legally wedded wife.

The learned Single Judge considered that issue and noticing that there is no finding recorded by the Tribunal regarding maintainability of the application as such, hence, remitted the matter back to the Tribunal.

There is no error in the order passed by the learned Single Judge. Any

expression of opinion by this court on merits would adversely affect either of the parties.

Accordingly, the appeal is dismissed. Consequently, the application for condonation of delay is also dismissed.
