Order passed by the learned Single Judge allowing the respondent No.1's writ petition has been impugned by filing the present intra-court appeal. Alongwith the appeal, applications seeking condonation of delay of 65 days in filing and 53 days in re-filing the appeal have also been filed.

Respondent No.1 had approached this Court *inter alia* for the issuance of a direction to the appellant and respondents No.2 to 4 to appoint her as a Steno-Typist in furtherance of letter dated 01.09.2010 as she was fully eligible. During the course of hearing, the learned Single Judge, after considering the submissions made by learned counsel for the parties, passed

a detailed order on 03.10.2017, which has been noticed in the order impugned in the present appeal. The only information sought through the aforesaid interim order was regarding availability of posts. Subsequent there to, an affidavit was filed by the State stating that there were still 17 posts of Steno-Typist lying vacant in the Department. It was in terms thereof that the Transport Commissioner was directed to appoint respondent No.1 as Steno-Typist. The issue regarding grant of benefits other than actual pay, from the date application is accepted, was ordered to be decided by the Transport Commissioner on making representation by respondent No.1.

In the above discussions, there is no error in the order passed by the learned Single Judge. The present appeal is dismissed and consequently, the applications for condonation of delay in filing and re-filing of the appeal are also dismissed.
