The only direction given by the learned Single Judge is for decision on the legal notice got served by the writ petitioner/ respondent no.5, with reference to grant of his retiral benefits.

We do not find any error in the order passed by the learned Single Judge as no decision has been given on merits.

The plea raised by learned counsel for the appellant is that time of 45 days granted for payment, if the writ petitioner is found entitled to any relief, is too short as the society is running into losses. We are not impressed with the arguments advanced. It is for the society to arrange for payment of its legal dues especially salary or retiral due to its employees.

There is no error in the order passed by the learned Single Judge. The appeal is dismissed. Consequently, the application for condonation of delay in filing the appeal is also dismissed.
